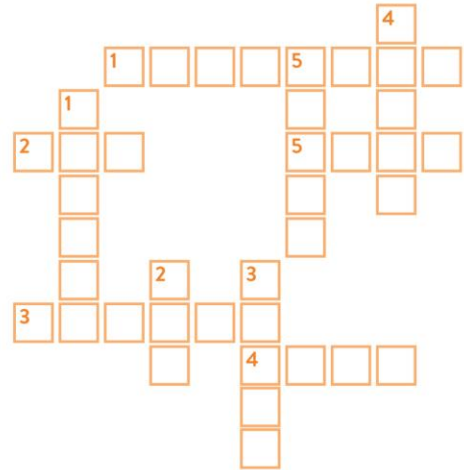

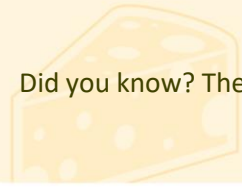


### CRUNCH VEGGIES AND FRESH CHEESE 🥕🧀

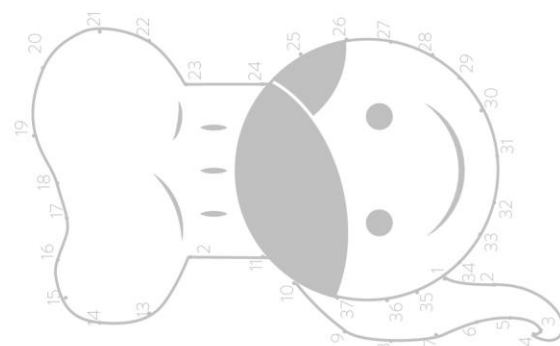
