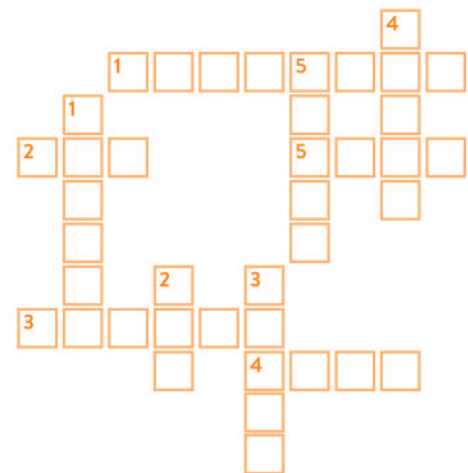

### KRISPIE FISH FINGERS WITH FRIES

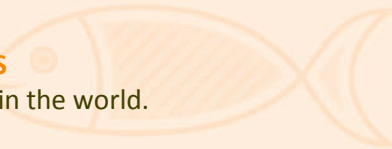
Did you know? Fish fingers were created during Antiquity.

### SAUTÉED POTATOES

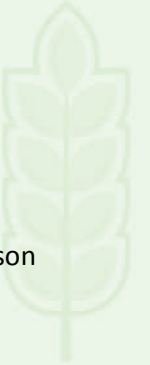
Did you know? Potatoes were grown by the Incas in the 13<sup>th</sup> century.

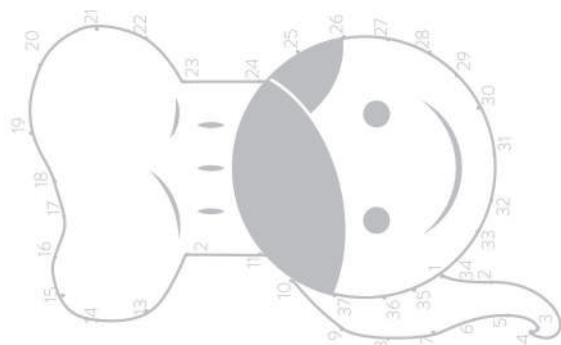
